## ✓ Cook County to Rollout Property Tax Relief

- \$15 million program
- Eligibility criteria
- Income: \$119,000 or less (4 person household; \$1,000 payment)
- Property tax increased by at least 50% in any year since 2021 tax year
- Application website expected to open this summer

### ✓ City Vehicle Stickers

- \$50; must be displayed by May 31st
- \$100 late fee starting June 1<sup>st</sup> per city ordinance
- Residents 65 or older receive 1 free passenger sticker per household; second sticker at a discounted rate of \$15. Proof of age required.
